




## Our Impact

Planting trees is the quickest, most efficient, and most cost-effective way to remove carbon from the air and combat climate change.

Our goal is to plant a million trees to store carbon, help mitigate the effects of global warming, protect soils and water, extend habitat for biodiversity and rebuild a thriving economy. Survival rate for our trees is currently 89%.






### A Sustainable Investment

By partnering with Iracambi, your business will deliver a lasting impact for decades to come.



### Where The Money Goes





A proportion is allocated to administration which keeps Iracambi operating.



#### **Nursery** \$ 0.50 (14%)

Cost per tree planted & maintained for two years is \$3.55 (excluding the cost of land purchase).
















# Impact Timescale
